**Subject:** CorVel Contract for Certified Managed Health Care Services – Ergonomic Services

### **Background:**

Under the prior contract for certified managed health care services agencies could access ergonomic services for loss control purposes. The provision of ergonomic services in which there is no workers' compensation claim was not included in the new contract with CorVel that is effective July 1, 2013.


### **Requested Action**

If your agency wants to request these types of services from CorVel or another vendor, you will need to contact Administration's Materials Management Division at (651) 296-2600 or through their WebPages at <http://www.mmd.admin.state.mn.us> to determine the appropriate type of agreement your agency needs to use for these services.

If the employee has an open workers' compensation claim and an ergonomic assessment is specifically related to their workers' compensation claim, you should work with the workers' compensation claims management specialist as any expense related to this assessment might be covered under the workers' compensation claim.
