



Minnesota Population Projections by Race and Hispanic Origin, 2005 to 2035

- The percent of Minnesota's population that is nonwhite or Latino is projected to grow from 14 percent in 2005 to 25 percent in 2035.
- The numbers of Latino, black, and Asian Minnesotans are projected to more than double over the next 30 years.
- The white population is projected to grow slowly and will decline in some parts of the state.
- All regions of the state will become more racially and ethnically diverse than they are now.

This report presents population projections by race and ethnicity for the State of Minnesota, each Development Region, and counties that had a total minority population of 10,000 or more in 2005. The race groups are: white alone, not Latino; black or African American alone, not Latino; Asian and Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander alone, not Latino; American Indian or Alaska Native alone, not Latino; and two or more races, not Latino. The Hispanic or Latino population is also projected. These race and ethnic groups add up to the total state population.

Summary of Results

Because the white population is older on average, experiences little or no in-migration, and has a slightly lower fertility rate, it is not projected to show much growth. The total white alone population is projected to increase about 4 percent between 2005 and 2015 and show little growth thereafter. Overall, the white population is projected to grow nine percent over 30 years, compared to 112 percent for the total minority population. The proportion of the population that is white alone, not Latino is projected to fall from 86 percent in 2005 to 75 percent in 2035.

The Latino population is projected to rise rapidly, growing from an estimated 196,300 in 2005 to 324,400 in 2015 and 551,600 in 2035. All regions of the state are expected to see increases. About two-thirds of the total Latino population are projected to live in the seven-county Twin Cities area by 2035.

Large gains are also projected for the black or African American alone population. This group is projected to grow from 218,400 in 2005 to 454,400 in 2035. Rapid increases are anticipated for all regions, but the black population will remain concentrated in the Twin Cities area. The Twin Cities is projected to account for 83 percent of the state total black population in 2035.

The Asian/Hawaiian/Pacific Islander population is projected to grow from 183,300 in 2005 to 391,400 in 2035, a gain of 114 percent. The Twin Cities will be home to about 82 percent of the state total in 2035, the projections show.

Much slower growth is projected for the American Indian alone population, only 13 percent between 2005 and 2035. It should be noted that the trend data for American Indians are erratic and probably less reliable than for some other groups. People who identify as American Indians often identify with another race as well, so it is likely that many people with American Indian heritage appear in the two or more races group. The projections show declining American Indian populations in Hennepin and Ramsey counties. By 2035, it is anticipated that about 28 percent of the American Indian alone population will live in these two counties.

Substantial gains are expected for the two or more races population, with the population almost doubling over 30 years. About two thirds are expected to live in the Twin Cities area.

All regions will be more racially and ethnically diverse in the future than they are now. By 2035, 48 percent of Ramsey County residents and 44 percent of Hennepin County residents are projected to be nonwhite or Latino. In suburban counties, the proportion of residents who are minorities is expected to double during that same period.

Methodology

The state population by race and ethnicity was projected first. The regional and county totals were projected second and were controlled (raked) to the state totals. Raking means that the regional totals for each race and ethnic group were summed and then compared to the previously projected state total. If the sum was larger than the state total, all areas were adjusted downward in a proportional manner so they would add up to the state total. If the sum was smaller than the state figure, all the regional totals were adjusted upward.

In regions where some counties had 10,000 or more total minority population in 2005, the projection was done for the county and for the balance of the region. The affected regions include Region 2 (Beltrami County and balance of region), Region 3 (St. Louis County and balance of region) and Region 10 (Olmsted County and balance of region). In Region 11, the Twin Cities area, all counties were projected individually. In the final results for Regions 2, 3, 10 and 11, the regional total is the sum of the parts.

State Projections Methodology

The procedure used to project the white alone, not Latino population differed from the method used to project the other race and ethnic groups. The white alone, not Latino statewide population was projected using the cohort component method. The cohort component method begins with the 2005 population by age and gender and applies rates of fertility, mortality and migration to obtain the population at the next time period, 2010. The result is a population where each cohort is five years older than in 2005. Babies born during the five-year period become the new under age 5 population. This process is then repeated for five-year intervals going out to 2035.

The 2005 white populations ages 0 to 14 and 25 to 49 were adjusted upward as was done in the State Demographic Center projections of the total population published in 2007. Migration was assumed to be zero. Fertility rates by age were held constant at 2005 levels. Mortality was assumed to be the same as for the total population.

For the other race and ethnic groups, the projection was done using a time series of the proportion of the total population in each group. These proportions were calculated using Census Bureau estimates for the years 1990 to 2007. Two regression equations were then calculated. One was based on the linear trend in the Minnesota proportion in each specified group, without regard to the national data. The second was based on the ratio of each group's share of the Minnesota population to the national share of the population in the same group.

The results of these two equations were then extrapolated into the future to project the future proportions, and the results were compared to national projections done by the U.S. Bureau of the Census. For the white, Latino and Asian/Hawaiian/Pacific Islander populations, the linear trend in the proportion was used. For the black population, the trend in the ratio between the state and national proportions was used.

Creating a meaningful time series for the two or more races population was difficult because the data do not start until 2000. The U.S. and Minnesota proportions are similar for the 2000 to 2007 period, so the U.S. projected proportions were used for Minnesota.

The trend line for American Indians has been erratic over time. For American Indians, the average difference between the U.S. and Minnesota proportions between 2000 and 2007 was held constant into the future.

Once the future proportions were calculated, they were summed and then controlled to a total of 1.000. Next, the results of the cohort component projection for the white alone population were substituted for the regression results for whites. The proportions for the other race and ethnic groups were then readjusted so the total summed to 1.000. The resulting ratios were applied to the total projected future population published by the State Demographic Center in 2007.

Regions and Selected Counties Methodology

For all development regions and for counties with a minority population of at least 10,000, two similar time series of linear equations were calculated using the trends in the proportion of the total population and in the ratio of the area proportion to the national proportion. These equations were then carried out into the future and the results compared to the national trends.

For the white alone and black alone populations, the equation for the linear trend in the ratio was used for the county and regional projections. For the Latino and Asian/Hawaiian/Pacific Islander alone populations, the trend in the proportion was used. The proportional trend line was also used for the American Indian/Alaska Native population, except in the counties in the Twin Cities Area, where the trend data showed an extremely rapid decline. In the Twin Cities, the American Indian proportion was kept constant at the average 2000 to 2007 level. For the two or more races population, the proportions were kept constant at 2007 levels.

The resulting proportions were then multiplied by the projected total population in the area. The projected race/ethnic group totals were then raked to the projected total population in the region. Those totals were raked again to the projected statewide population in each race and ethnic group. These two rakes were then repeated. The final results add to the state totals by race and ethnicity. They are close, but not identical, to the projected total regional or county population in the 2007 projections series from the State Demographic Center. County and regional numbers are rounded to the nearest 10 and state numbers to the nearest 100.

Sources of Error in the Projections

There are many sources of error in population projections, and there are even more pitfalls in race and ethnicity projections. The initial estimated population may be too high or too low. The equations used to project future proportions may not be optimal. The U.S. Census Bureau projections used for comparison purposes may be wrong.

Racial and ethnic groups are social, not biological, categories, and they change over time. For example, the Hispanic/Latino category was not used in Census data before 1970, and multiple race data was not collected before 2000. It is likely that racial and ethnic concepts will continue to change in the future. New identities may emerge. The growing diversity of the population and the increase in the number of people of mixed backgrounds could make racial identity less salient. On the other hand, unforeseen societal changes could lead to more focus on racial differences than we have now.
