**ORDER FOR REVOCATION
OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER**
Board File No. 2006-0057

1. The Minnesota Board of Architecture, Engineering, Land Surveying, Landscape Architecture, Geoscience and Interior Design ("Board") is authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 326.02-326.15 (2005) to license, regulate, and discipline persons who apply for, or hold a profession engineer license in the State of Minnesota and is further authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 326.111 and 214.10 (2005) to initiate appropriate disciplinary action.

2. Edward L. Lukacsek ("Respondent") has been and is now subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a professional engineering license.

3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 270C.72, subd. 1 (2005), the Board must revoke a professional license if the license holder owes delinquent state taxes, penalties, or interest, and the Minnesota Commissioner of Revenue so notifies the Board.

4. On April 3, 2006, the Board received a Notice of License Revocation from the Minnesota Department of Revenue, which advised the Board that Respondent has an outstanding tax liability. Under Minn. Stat. § 270C.72 (2005), the Board must revoke Respondent's license.

ORDER


1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent's license shall be REVOKED pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 270C.72, subd. 1 (2005). During the period of revocation Respondent shall not offer to perform or perform any services in this state that require licensure as an engineer, including holding himself out to the public as an engineer.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that during the period of revocation, Respondent shall remove the designation of being a licensed engineer from all Respondent's advertisements, business cards, business forms, and signage.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the revocation shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until the Board receives a Tax Clearance Certificate from the Minnesota Department of Revenue indicating that Respondent does not owe the State any uncontested delinquent taxes, penalties, or interest and has filed all required returns. If a Tax Clearance Certificate is received, the Board shall then issue an Order to rescind this revocation of Respondent's license.
