**ORDER FOR REVOCATION
OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER AND
LAND SURVEYOR LICENSE**

Professional Engineer License No. 9587

1. The Minnesota Board of Architecture, Engineering, Land Surveying, Landscape Architecture, Geoscience and Interior Design ("Board") is authorized pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 326.02-326.15 (2010) to license, regulate, and discipline persons who apply for, or hold a professional engineering license or hold a land surveyor license in the State of Minnesota and is further authorized pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 326.111 and Minnesota Statutes section 214.10 (2010) to initiate appropriate disciplinary action.

2. Willis L. Gilliard ("Respondent") has been and is now subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a professional engineering and a land surveyor license.

3. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 270C.72, subdivision 1 (2010), the Board must revoke a professional license if the license holder owes delinquent state taxes, penalties, or interest, and the Minnesota Commissioner of Revenue so notifies the Board.

4. On July 26, 2010, the Board received a Notice of License Revocation from the Minnesota Department of Revenue, which advised the Board that Respondent has not filed Minnesota tax returns as requested. Under Minnesota Statutes section 270C.72 (2010), the Board must revoke Respondent's professional engineer and land surveyor licenses.

ORDER

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent's professional engineering and land surveyor licenses shall be REVOKED pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 270C.72, subdivision 1 (2010). During the period of revocation Respondent shall not offer to perform or


perform any services in this state that require licensure as an engineer and or as a land surveyor, including holding himself out to the public as a professional engineer or a land surveyor.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that during the period of revocation, Respondent shall remove the designation of being a licensed professional engineer and a licensed land surveyor from all Respondent's advertisements, business cards, business forms, and signage.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the revocation shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until the Board receives a Clearance Certificate from the Minnesota Department of Revenue indicating that Respondent does not owe the State any uncontested delinquent taxes, penalties, or interest and has filed all required returns. If a Clearance Certificate is received, the Board shall then issue an Order to rescind this revocation of Respondent's professional engineer and land surveyor licenses.
