The Minnesota Board of Architecture, Engineering, Land Surveying, Landscape Architecture, Geoscience and Interior Design ("Board") is authorized pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 214.10 (2010) and Minnesota Statutes section 326.111 (2010) to review complaints against architects, professional engineers, land surveyors, landscape architects, geoscientists, and certified interior designers, and to take disciplinary action whenever appropriate.

The Board received information concerning John Whalen ("Respondent"). The Board's Complaint Committee ("Committee") reviewed the information. The parties have agreed that the matter may now be resolved by this Stipulation and Order.

STIPULATION

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between Respondent and the Committee as follows:

1. <u>Jurisdiction.</u> The Respondent was first issued a Professional Engineer license by the Board on September 11, 2001. Respondent is subject to the jurisdiction of

the Board with respect to the matters referred to in this Stipulation.

- 2. Facts. This Stipulation is based upon the following facts:
- a. Respondent was first licensed as a Professional Engineer in the State of Minnesota on September 11, 2001.
- b. On July 1, 2010, Respondent's Minnesota Professional Engineer license in the State of Minnesota expired.
- c. On February 1, 2011, Respondent's Minnesota Professional Engineer license was reinstated.
- d. Respondent's Minnesota Professional Engineer license is current with an expiration date of June 30, 2012.
- e. During the time Respondent's license was lapsed (July 1, 2010 until February 1, 2011), Respondent admits that he held himself out and practiced as a Professional Engineer. In a letter dated January 25, 2011, that was attached to the Application for License/Certificate Reinstatement through 6/30/2012, Respondent stated: "Unfortunately, I am unable to sign the Affidavit for Reinstatement because I have provided Professional Engineering Services since the time my license lapsed." A true and correct copy of the January 25, 2011, letter with the Application for License/Certificate Reinstatement through 6/30/2012, is attached as Exhibit A.
- f. In a letter dated February 28, 2011, Respondent stated: "Please accept the following as a response to the allegation that I practiced professional engineering in the state of Minnesota during a lapse in my license from July 1,

2010 until February 1, 2011. I have self reported this violation, and offered the following explanation in my request for reinstatement." A true and correct copy of the letter dated February 28, 2011, is attached as Exhibit B.

- g. In the same letter dated February 28, 2011, Exhibit B, Respondent provided a list of eight (8) Minnesota projects that he signed and certified the plans for from July 1, 2011 until February 1, 2011.

- 3. <u>Violations.</u> Respondent admits that the facts specified above constitute violations of Minnesota Statutes section 326.02, subdivisions 1 and 3 (2010) and are sufficient grounds for the action specified below. Specifically, the Committee's position is that the Respondent held himself out as a Professional Engineer and practiced engineering during the lapse of his Professional Engineer's license, from July 1, 2010 until February 1, 2011.
- 4. <u>Enforcement Action.</u> Respondent and the Committee agree that the Board should issue an Order in accordance with the following terms:

- a. <u>Reprimand.</u> Respondent is reprimanded for the foregoing conduct.
- b. <u>Civil Penalty.</u> Respondent shall pay to the Board a civil penalty of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). Respondent shall submit a civil penalty of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) by cashier's check or money order to the Board within sixty (60) days of the Board's approval of this Stipulation and Order.
- 5. <u>Additional Discipline for Violations of Order.</u> If Respondent violates this Stipulation and Order, the Board may impose additional discipline pursuant to the following procedure:
- a. The Committee shall schedule a hearing before the Board. At least thirty days prior to the hearing, the Committee shall mail Respondent a notice of the violation alleged by the Committee and of the time and place of the hearing. Within fourteen days after the notice is mailed, Respondent shall submit a response to the allegations. If Respondent does not submit a timely response to the Board, the allegations may be deemed admitted.
- b. At the hearing before the Board, the Complaint Committee and Respondent may submit affidavits made on personal knowledge and argument based on the record in support of their positions. The Complaint Committee may submit affidavits responding to any affidavits submitted by Respondent. The evidentiary record before the Board shall be limited to such affidavits and this Stipulation and Order. Respondent waives a hearing before an administrative law judge and waives discovery, cross-examination of adverse witnesses, and other procedures governing administrative hearings or civil trials.

- c. At the hearing, the Board will determine whether to impose additional disciplinary action, including additional conditions or limitations on Respondent's practice or suspension or revocation of Respondent's license.
- 6. Waiver of Respondent's Rights. For the purpose of this Stipulation, Respondent waives all procedures and proceedings before the Board to which Respondent may be entitled under the Minnesota and United States constitutions, statutes, or the rules of the Board, including the right to dispute the allegations against Respondent, to dispute the appropriateness of discipline in a contested case proceeding pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 14 (2010), and to dispute the civil penalty imposed by this Agreement. Respondent agrees that upon the application of the Committee without notice to or an appearance by Respondent, the Board may issue an Order containing the enforcement action specified in paragraph 4 herein. Respondent waives the right to any judicial review of the Order by appeal, writ of certiorari, or otherwise.
- 7. <u>Collection.</u> In accordance with Minnesota Statutes section 16D.17 (2010), in the event this order becomes final and Respondent does not comply with the condition in paragraph 4(b) above, Respondent agrees that the Board may file and enforce the unpaid portion of the civil penalty as a judgment without further notice or additional proceedings.
- 8. <u>Board Rejection of Stipulation and Order.</u> In the event the Board in its discretion does not approve this Stipulation and Order or a lesser remedy than specified herein, this Stipulation and Order shall be null and void and shall not be used for any

purpose by either party hereto. If this Stipulation is not approved and a contested case proceeding is initiated pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 14 (2010), Respondent agrees not to object to the Board's initiation of the proceedings and hearing the case on the basis that the Board has become disqualified due to its review and consideration of this Stipulation and the record.

- 9. <u>Unrelated Violations.</u> This settlement shall not in any way or manner limit or affect the authority of the Board to proceed against Respondent by initiating a contested case hearing or by other appropriate means on the basis of any act, conduct, or admission of Respondent justifying disciplinary action which occurred before or after the date of this Stipulation and Order and which is not directly related to the specific facts and circumstances set forth herein.
- 10. Record. The Stipulation, related investigative reports and other documents shall constitute the entire record of the proceedings herein upon which the Order is based. The investigative reports, other documents, or summaries thereof may be filed with the Board with this Stipulation.
- 11. <u>Data Classification.</u> Under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, this Stipulation and Order is classified as public data upon its issuance by the Board, Minnesota Statutes section 13.41, subdivision 5 (2010). All documents in the record shall maintain the data classification to which they are entitled under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 13 (2010). They shall not, to the extent they are not already public documents, become public merely because they are referenced herein. A summary of this Order will appear in the Board's newsletter.

A summary will also be sent to the national discipline data bank pertaining to the practice of engineering.

12. <u>Entire Agreement.</u> Respondent has read, understood, and agreed to this Stipulation and is freely and voluntarily signing it. The Stipulation contains the entire agreement between the parties hereto relating to the allegations referenced herein. Respondent is not relying on any other agreement or representations of any kind, verbal or otherwise.

13. <u>Counsel</u>. Respondent is aware that he may choose to be represented by legal counsel in this matter. Respondent knowingly waived legal representation.

14. <u>Service.</u> If approved by the Board, a copy of this Stipulation and Order shall be served personally or by first class mail on Respondent. The Order shall be effective and deemed issued when it is signed by the Chair of the Board.

Please find enclosed an Application for License/Certificate Reinstatement through 6/30/2012 as well as a check for \$192.00. Unfortunately, I am unable to sign the Affidavit for Reinstatement because I have provided Professional Engineering Services since the time my license lapsed.

The lapse of my license was inadvertent, and the work I performed was done with the honest belief that my license was current. I take full responsibility for this lapse, and am offering the following only so that the Board will have a better understanding of what has happened. It appears that I had a complete breakdown in the system I was using to maintain my license renewals. The main reason for the breakdown was my change in employment. I used my electronic calendar on my desktop computer to maintain my license renewals. I had it set up to give advanced warning of a license renewal. In my attempt to use my smart phone to transfer my electronic calendar data from my desktop computer at my old employer to my new employer some of the calendar information got changed. At the time of the transfer, I was concerned that this might happen, so I reviewed the transferred information. Unfortunately, I didn't catch that there was an error in the renewal date for my Minnesota license. My back-up system for renewals was the reminder card that was sent out by the Board. It was my belief that all of my renewals were being sent to my home address, but I have recently learned that my Minnesota renewal was sent to my former employer. I deeply regret that this has happened, and regret that my actions have inconvenienced the Board.
