


Configuring Adobe Flash Player for e-Learning

When launching e-Learning courses in your browser, you may receive a security warning. If so, you should adjust your Adobe Flash Player settings to ensure the e-Learning functions properly.

To adjust your settings, click Global Settings, Advanced Tab, Trusted Location Settings and Add..., and type the web address of the e-Learning (i.e. <http://mn.gov/admin-stat/ogm-fraud-prevention/>) in the Website Domain field.

Full step-by-step instructions for adjusting your Flash Player settings are listed below:


1a. If prompted with the following Adobe Flash Player Security Warning, click the Settings button.




1b. Alternatively, open the e-Learning, right click on the screen and click Global Settings.




2. The Internet Explorer Security alert may appear. If so, click Allow.




3. The Flash Player Settings Manager appears. Click the Advanced Tab.




4. Scroll down to the Developer Tools section and Click Trusted Location Settings




5. In the Trusted Location Settings window, Click Add.



6. In the Add Site window, type the URL of the e-Learning into the Website Domain field. Click Confirm.



7. When the URL location appears in the Trusted File window, click Close.



8. Return to your browser and close the e-Learning course. Re-launch the e-Learning course to proceed with your new settings in place.
