ORDER OF DENIAL
OF PETITION

The Minnesota Board of Psychology (hereinafter "Board") convened on May 15, 1992, and again on July 24, 1992, to review and consider the evidence submitted by James Alsdurf, LP (hereinafter "Licensee"), in support of his petition for removal of the restrictions and conditions placed upon his license as a psychologist in the State of Minnesota. Based on the evidence presented, the Board issues the following ORDER:

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Licensee's petition for removal of the restrictions and conditions placed on his license as a psychologist in the State of Minnesota is DENIED based upon Licensee's failure to meet the burden of proof according to paragraph 5 of the Stipulation and Consent Order of Restricted and Conditional License issued to Licensee on November 3, 1989, by failing to meet the requirements of paragraph 3 b.(8 and 9) of the stipulation order;

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Licensee may petition the Board to have the restrictions and conditions removed from his license no sooner than the first regularly scheduled meeting following December 1, 1992. His license may be reinstated, if at all, as the evidence dictates and based upon the need to protect the public. The burden of proof shall be upon Licensee to demonstrate by clear and convincing evidence that he is capable of conducting himself in a fit and competent manner in the practice of psychology. In petitioning for removal of the restrictions and conditions, Licensee shall provide the Board with, at a minimum, the following:

a. Evidence of Licensee's ability to maintain proper boundaries;

b. Evidence of Licensee's ability to practice as a licensed psychologist.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Stipulation and Consent Order of Restricted and Conditional License issued to Licensee on November 3, 1989, shall remain in full force and effect;

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board may, at any regularly scheduled meeting at which Licensee has appeared and presented evidence, take any of the following actions:

- a. Remove the restrictions and conditions placed upon Licensee's license;
- b. Reissue a license to Licensee conditional upon further reports to the Board and/or restrictions placed upon the scope of Licensee's practice;
- c. Continue the restrictions and conditions of Licensee's license upon his failure to meet the burden of proof.
