**ORDER OF REMOVAL OF
STAY OF SUSPENSION**

This matter came before the Complaint Panel of the Minnesota Board of Marriage and Family Therapy ("Board") in accordance with the terms of a Stipulation and Consent Order ("2015 Consent Order"), which Amy Lee-Jones, LMFT ("Respondent"), agreed to and signed on January 16, 2015.

Pursuant to the 2015 Consent Order, Respondent's marriage and family therapy license was suspended, but the suspension was stayed contingent upon Respondent's compliance with all terms and conditions set forth in the 2015 Consent Order. In paragraph 5 of the 2015 Consent Order, Respondent agreed that the Complaint Panel is authorized to issue an Order of Removal of Stay of Suspension ("Order of Removal") if it has probable cause to believe Respondent violated any of the requirements for staying the suspension of Respondent's license in the 2015 Consent Order.

The Complaint Panel has probable cause to believe Respondent violated one or more of the requirements for staying the suspension of Respondent's license in the <Year> Consent Order.

ORDER

1. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stay of suspension set forth in the 2015 Consent Order is **REMOVED**, and the license of Respondent as a marriage and family therapist in the State of Minnesota is **SUSPENDED** immediately.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's license as a marriage and family therapist in the State of Minnesota shall remain suspended until the Board makes a final determination in this matter.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's violation of this Order shall provide grounds for further disciplinary action pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 148B.01 to 148B.39 (2014).

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Board shall conduct a hearing pursuant to paragraph 6 of the 2015 Consent Order. After that hearing, the Board may take any of the following actions:

a. Dismiss the Complaint Panel's allegations and reinstate Respondent's license under the terms of the 2015 Consent Order.


b. Reinstate Respondent's license with limitations placed upon the scope of Respondent's practice and/or conditional upon further reports to the Board.

- c. Continue the suspension of Respondent's license.
- d. Impose any other form of discipline permitted by Minnesota Statutes sections 148B.01 to 148B.39 (2014).
