ORDER OF SUSPENSION

1. The Minnesota Board of Physical Therapy ("Board") is authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 148.65 through 148.78 (2012) to license, regulate, and discipline persons who apply for, petition, or hold licenses to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota and is further authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 214.10 and 214.103 (2012) to review complaints against licensees, to refer such complaints to the Minnesota Attorney General's Office, and to initiate appropriate disciplinary action.

2. Todd S. Chilson, P.T. ("Respondent"), has been and now is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota.

3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 214.101, subds. 1 and 4 (2012), the license of a physical therapist must be suspended if the licensee is found by a court, administrative law judge, or public authority to be in arrears in child support or maintenance payments or both.

4. On or about October 19, 2013, the Board received a Notice to Suspend Occupational or Professional License(s) from Wadena County Human Services, Office of Child Support, Wadena, Minnesota, which advised the Board that Respondent is not in compliance with a court order for child support; and that under Minn. Stat. §§ 214.101 and 518A.66 (2012), the Board must suspend Respondent's license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota.

5. The authority to sign orders suspending licenses pursuant to a Notice to Suspend Occupational or Professional License(s) has been delegated to the Executive Director of the Board.

ORDER

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent's license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota shall be **SUSPENDED** pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 518A.66 (2012), effective **November 15, 2013**. During the period of suspension, Respondent may not engage in the practice of physical therapy, as defined by Minn. Stat. § 148.65, subd. 1 (2012), in the State of Minnesota.

2. Within ten days of the date of this Order, Licensee must provide the Board with a list of all work sites and locations at which Licensee currently has privileges, a list of all states in which Licensee is licensed or has applied for licensure, and the addresses and telephone numbers of Licensee's residences and all work sites. Within seven days of any change, Licensee must provide the Board with the new address and telephone information. The information must be sent to Stephanie Lunning, Minnesota Board of Physical Therapy, University Park Plaza,
2829 University Avenue S.E., Suite 420, Minneapolis, Minnesota 55414-3664.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the suspension will remain in effect until such time as the Board receives notification from the court, administrative law judge, or public authority that referred this matter to the Board confirming that Respondent is in compliance with his court order for child support.
