**ORDER**

The Minnesota Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board ("Board"), having convened on July 17, 2008 to review the petition of Brian DeLong, EMT-P ("Respondent") for an unconditional certificate to perform paramedic services in Minnesota, makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. By Stipulation and Order dated January 24, 2008, the Board granted Respondent a conditional EMT-P certificate, but immediately suspended the certificate for a minimum of three months, or until successful completion of an approved ethics course and written report, whichever was later. The Stipulation and Order was based on Respondent's alteration of his expired EMT-B certificate to make it appear valid.

2. Respondent completed the approved ethics course, submitted a written report, and petitioned the Board for removal of his suspension and issuance of an unconditional EMT-P certificate in the State of Minnesota.

3. Based on the foregoing, the Board concludes that Respondent has complied with and fulfilled the terms and conditions of the Stipulation and Order issued by the Board on January 24, 2008, and hereby issues the following order:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the suspended status of Respondent be removed, and an unconditional EMT-P certificate be conferred upon Respondent, such certificate to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
