Nature of Misconduct: Violating an order of the Board; unethical and unprofessional conduct, inability to practice medicine due to illness; and failure to maintain adequate medical records.

Action Taken: Dr. Beyer's license, which was suspended on March 30, 2016, is reinstated. His license is suspended with the suspension stayed contingent upon his compliance with the following:

1. He shall participate in the Health Professionals Services Program (HPSP) and comply fully with all terms and conditions of his HPSP Participation Agreement and Monitoring Plan.
2. He shall obtain a pre-approved primary care treating physician who shall submit quarterly reports to the Board.
3. He shall obtain a pre-approved treating psychiatrist who shall submit quarterly reports to the Board.
4. He shall engage in individual therapy as recommended by his treating psychiatrist.
5. He shall successfully complete, within 121 days of this Order, the following pre-approved courses:
 - a. Chemical dependency awareness.
 - b. Medical records management.
 - c. Professional boundaries.
6. He shall be subject to random chart audits of his practice during this Order.
7. He shall maintain a daily log of controlled substance prescriptions he authorizes.
8. He shall practice in a pre-approved group setting.
9. He shall obtain a pre-approved on-site supervising physician who shall submit quarterly reports to the Board.
10. He shall meet quarterly with a designated Board member.
11. He may petition for reinstatement of an unconditional license upon submission of satisfactory evidence of three years of documented, uninterrupted compliance and stable mental health, and completion of the terms and conditions of this Order.

Action Taken: Dr. Burke's license is conditioned as follows:

1. He is reprimanded.
 2. He shall read the Model Policy for pain control published by the Federation of State Medical Boards and *Responsible Opioid Prescribing, A Clinician's Guide*, 2nd Edition, Revised, by Scott M. Fishman, M.D.
 3. He shall complete, within one year, the following pre-approved courses:
 - a. Chemical dependency awareness.
 - b. Chronic pain management.
 4. Upon completion of the readings and the coursework, he shall write a paper describing what he has learned from the coursework, how he might have treated the patient of the investigation differently, and how he will implement this knowledge into his practice.
 5. He shall pay a \$2,500 civil penalty.
 6. He may petition for reinstatement of an unconditional upon completion of the terms of this Order.

Action Taken: Dr. Green's license is conditioned as follows:

1. He is reprimanded.
2. He shall retain and use a pre-approved billing service.
3. He shall read the Model Policy for pain control published by the Federation of State Medical Boards and *Responsible Opioid Prescribing, A Clinician's Guide*, 2nd Edition Revised, by Scott M. Fishman, M.D.
4. He shall complete, within one year, the following pre-approved courses:
 - i. Chronic pain management.
 - ii. Suboxone prescribing.
 - iii. Medical records management.

5. Six months following his successful completion of the pre-approved courses, he shall undergo an audit of his prescribing practices.
6. He shall maintain records that reflect the patient complaint, clinical findings, treatment plan, response to treatment, and prescriptions authorized, including refills.
7. He shall obtain a pre-approved supervising physician who shall submit quarterly reports to the Board.
8. He shall develop, and submit for Committee approval, a Suboxone agreement.
9. He shall document use of the Minnesota Prescription Monitoring Program.
10. He shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,023.50.
11. He may petition for reinstatement of an unconditional license upon completion of the terms of this Order.
