

Dear Ambulance Service Manager:

The Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board (EMSRB) is seeking requests for reimbursements for those ambulance services that can demonstrate extraordinary costs with the public health threat posed by Ebola. These requests must be submitted and received by the EMSRB no later than March 31, 2016, at 4:00 PM.

The Minnesota legislature appropriated \$148,000.00 to ambulance services who can demonstrate extraordinary costs directly attributable to maintaining a state of readiness with respect to the public health threat posed by Ebola. The EMSRB has been tasked with proportionally allocating this grant to service providers.

Those services that consider the measures and expense they incurred extraordinary are encouraged to apply for this appropriation. Attached to this e-mail and posted on our website (<http://mn.gov/boards/emsrb/grantprojects/projects/ebolareadiness.jsp>) is detailed information about the request for reimbursement, requirements, as well as the materials needed to apply. Please note the requirements section is quite long, but not all requirements need to be met in order to have a successful application.
