ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL AND UNLIMITED
LICENSE

The Minnesota Board of Psychology (Board) convened on June 17, 2016, to review the petition of Eric Felch, Psy.D, LP (Licensee) for removal of the conditions and limitations placed on their license by a Stipulation and Consent Order, adopted and implemented by the Board on October 31, 2014 (October 2014 Order). Having considered the Complaint Resolution Committee's (Committee) recommendation that Licensee be granted an Unconditional and Unlimited license, the Board determines that Licensee has complied with and fulfilled all conditions set forth in the October 2104 Order as follows:

1. Pursuant to paragraph 4.a., Licensee practiced under the supervision of a licensed psychologist for a period of no less than twelve months.
2. Pursuant to paragraph 4.b., Licensee completed an individualized psychotherapy training course.
3. Pursuant to paragraph 4.b.1., Licensee submitted a report to the Committee on the individualized psychotherapy course.
4. Pursuant to paragraph 4.b.2., Licensee caused to be submitted a report to the Committee on the individualized psychotherapy course from the instructor of the course.
5. Pursuant to paragraph 4.c., Licensee underwent psychotherapy with a licensed psychologist for a period of no less than 12 months and caused to be submitted quarterly reports to the Committee.
6. Pursuant to paragraph 4.d., Licensee developed a peer consultation network.

The Committee has verified Licensee's compliance with the remedy listed in paragraph 4, and all subsequent paragraphs of the October 2014 Order.


Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

ORDER

Licensee shall be granted an **UNCONDITIONAL AND UNLIMITED LICENSE** to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
