**STIPULATION TO CEASE  
PRACTICING PODIATRIC MEDICINE**

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Board of Podiatric Medicine ("Board") received information that on, or about, October 14, 2015, Yev Gray, D.P.M. ("Licensee"), was charged in United States District Court for the Eastern District of Missouri, with one count of Conspiracy, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 371, and four counts of False Statements Involving Health Care Benefit Plan, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1035(a)(1) and § 2, alleged activities which could affect the license of Licensee to practice podiatric medicine;

WHEREAS, Licensee plans to refrain from practice of podiatric medicine in the State of Minnesota during the pendency of the above-referenced charges;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between Licensee and the Board that:

1. During all times herein Licensee has been and is now subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds a license to practice podiatric medicine.
2. The Board shall not pursue any disciplinary action against Licensee relating to the above-referenced criminal charges until after the criminal proceeding is concluded, provided Licensee complies with the Stipulation. However, the Board reserves its right to resume the disciplinary process if Licensee fails to comply with the terms herein or after the criminal proceeding is concluded or if the Board receives information of additional alleged violations.
3. Licensee shall personally deliver or mail his registration certificate to the Minnesota Board of Podiatric Medicine, c/o Ruth Grendahl, Executive Director, Suite 430,

2829 University Avenue S.E., Minneapolis, Minnesota 55414, within ten days after receipt of this Stipulation.

4. Licensee shall cease and desist from practicing podiatric medicine in any manner in the State of Minnesota and shall neither offer nor provide any such services within the state until this Stipulation is rescinded or modified.

5. Licensee may petition to have this Stipulation rescinded at any time Licensee is willing and able to participate with the Board in its review of the pending allegations made against Licensee. Licensee shall request to petition by submitting to the Board a written statement expressing an intent to address the pending allegations. At the time of petition, Licensee may be asked to meet with a Complaint Review Committee of the Board to review the pending allegations and any subsequently obtained information relative to Licensee's ability to practice podiatric medicine with reasonable skill and safety.

6. Licensee's noncompliance and violation of this Stipulation shall be considered a violation of Minnesota Statutes section 153.19 and constitute grounds for further disciplinary action.

7. Licensee agrees that should he violate the terms of this Stipulation, the following actions may be taken:

a. The Board may, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes ch. 14 and Minnesota Rules 1400.5100-1400.8400 and/or Minnesota Statutes section 214.077, refer any alleged violation to the Office of Administrative Hearings.

b. Should a violation be alleged, Licensee agrees that the issue before the administrative law judge may be limited as to whether a violation did in fact occur and whether there was sufficient or reasonable cause to excuse such violation. If the administrative law judge

finds that there has been a violation and there is not sufficient or reasonable cause to excuse such, he or she may make a recommendation of discipline.

c. Licensee agrees that, in the event the Board receives findings of the administrative law judge that there has been a violation of this Stipulation, the Board may order a suspension or revocation of Licensee's license to practice podiatric medicine or such lesser action or remedy as the Board deems appropriate.

d. Upon application of the Board, any appropriate court may enter a decree enforcing the terms of this Stipulation and prohibiting Licensee's practice of podiatric medicine until and unless the conditions of this Stipulation are fulfilled.

8. This Stipulation shall be classified as public data for purposes of Minnesota Statutes sections 13.02, subdivision 15 and 13.41, subdivision 5. Data regarding this action will be provided to data banks as required by Federal law or consistent with Board policy.

9. Having been duly advised of his right to counsel, Licensee acknowledges that he has read this Stipulation, understands the terms and conditions as set forth herein, and has freely and voluntarily signed this Stipulation.

10. This Stipulation contains the entire agreement between the Board and Licensee, there being no agreement of any kind, verbal or otherwise, which varies this Stipulation.
