Enclosed you will find a copy of the EMSRB Order of Suspension for your First Responder registration # 516399, effective April 24, 2006.

On March 22, 2006, a "Notice to Suspend Occupational or Professional License" was received from Scott County Human Services. Based upon Minnesota Statutes section 518.551, subdivision 12 and Minnesota Statutes section 214.101, subdivision 1, this Notice requires that the Board suspend your First Responder registration immediately.

Please note the conditions of this suspension as stated in the Order:

- Your First Responder registration # 516399 is suspended effective April 24, 2006. During the period of suspension, you may not represent yourself as an First Responder registered by the EMSRB in the State of Minnesota.
- Your registration may be reinstated by the Board upon receipt of clearance from Scott County Human Services, and compliance with the current requirements for reinstatement of your First Responder registration with the EMSRB.

**ORDER
OF SUSPENSION**

1. The Minnesota Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board (“Board”) is authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. ch. 144E to register persons as first responders in the State of Minnesota, to review complaints against registered first responders, and to initiate appropriate disciplinary action.

2. Shawn Hearn (“Registrant”) has been and now is subject to the jurisdiction of the Board and is registered as a first responder in the State of Minnesota.

3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 518.551, subd. 12, the registration of a first responder must be revoked if the Registrant is not in compliance with a court order for child support and appropriate authority so notifies the Board.

4. On March 22, 2006, the Board received a Notice of License Revocation from the Scott County Human Services, which advised the Board that the Registrant is not in compliance with a court order for child support, and under Minn. Stat. § 518.551, the Board must revoke registration as a first responder in the State of Minnesota. Scott County Human Services has informed the Board that, for purposes of Minn. Stat. § 518.551, Scott County Human Services deems the term “revoke” to mean that the taxpayer’s registration will be suspended until the child support obligation has been satisfied and the clearance certificate has been issued.

5. At a public meeting on January 17, 2002, the Board passed a motion delegating to the executive director the authority to (1) sign orders revoking or suspending certificates or registrations pursuant to child support delinquency notices, and (2) sign orders reinstating

certificates and registration upon compliance with all requirements set forth in the orders of suspension.

ORDER

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Registrant's registration as a first responder in the State of Minnesota shall be **SUSPENDED** pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 518.551, subd. 12, effective April 24, 2006. During the period of suspension, the Registrant shall not practice as a first responder in the State of Minnesota.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Registrant's registration shall be reinstated by the Board upon the Registrant's compliance with the following:

a. The Certificate Holder shall submit to the Board a child support clearance certificate from Scott County Human Services indicating that the Registrant does not owe any back child support; and

b. The Registrant shall comply with the requirements of Minn. Stat. § 144E.28, subd. 8, which also applies to expired registrations.
