**ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Physical Therapy ("Board"), having convened on July 19, 2012, to review the petition of Sandra Hepp, P.T. ("Licensee"), for reinstatement of an unconditional license to practice physical therapy, makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On March 18, 2010, the Board adopted a Stipulation and Order ("2010 Order") suspending Licensee's license due to chemical dependency and depression.
2. The 2010 Order indefinitely suspended Licensee's license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota. The 2010 Order provided that the suspension would be stayed if Licensee entered into a Participation Agreement and Monitoring Plan ("Participation Agreement") with the Health Professionals Services Program ("HPSP"). Licensee entered into a Participation Agreement with the HPSP and the suspension was stayed. The stay of suspension was to remain in effect so long as Licensee abstained completely from alcohol and all mood-altering chemicals unless prescribed by a physician or dentist who had first been informed of Licensee's chemical dependency and fully complied with the HPSP Participation Agreement and any modifications thereto as determined by HPSP.
3. The Board has received notification that Licensee has satisfied all of the conditions of the 2010 Order.

Based on the foregoing, the Board concludes that Licensee has complied with and fulfilled the 2010 Order and hereby issues the following:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Licensee, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
