**ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

The Minnesota Board of Physical Therapy (“Board”) having convened on May 19, 2005, to review the petition of Curtis A. Johnson, P.T. (“Respondent”), for reinstatement of an unconditional license to practice physical therapy makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. By Stipulation and Order dated March 20, 2003 (“Order”), the Board conditioned and restricted Respondent’s license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota. The Order was implemented due to Respondent’s inadequate supervision and inappropriate delegation of non-delegable duties to aides and inadequate documentation in patient records. Respondent was ordered to submit to and cooperate with quarterly practice reviews, successfully complete specified course work, attend quarterly meetings with a designated Board member, attend monthly meetings with a mentor/work quality assessor who provided quarterly reports, and pay a civil penalty of \$2,700.00. The Order was to remain in effect for a minimum of two years.

2. The Board has received confirmation that Respondent completed all requirements.

Based on the foregoing, the Board concludes that Respondent has complied with and fulfilled the Order issued by the Board on March 20, 2003, and hereby issues the following:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice physical therapy in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Respondent, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
