ORDER OF  
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE

The Minnesota Board of Psychology (hereinafter "Board"), having convened on June 14, 1996, to review the petition of Glenn Pickering, Ph.D., L.P. (hereinafter "Licensee"), for reinstatement of an unconditional license to practice psychology, determines that:

1. Licensee has completed a professional boundaries training course as required by the terms of a January 13, 1995 Stipulation and Consent Order which placed his license in a conditional status. The instructor of the boundaries course has submitted a report to the Complaint Resolution Committee (formerly known as the Discipline Committee) with respect to Licensee's participation in the course. The report supports the conclusion that Licensee has complied with the terms and conditions of the January 13, 1995 Stipulation and Consent Order.

2. Licensee has engaged in ethical consultation for a period of one year as required by the terms of the January 13, 1995 Stipulation and Consent Order. The consultant has completed reports with respect to Licensee's participation in ethical consultation. The reports support the conclusion that Licensee has complied with the terms and conditions of the January 13, 1995 Stipulation and Consent Order.

3. Licensee has submitted written reports to the Complaint Resolution Committee (formerly known as the Discipline Committee) addressing what he learned from the ethical consultations and the boundaries course and how this knowledge will affect his practice

in the future. The reports support the conclusion that Licensee has complied with the terms and conditions of the January 13, 1995 Stipulation and Consent Order.

4. Licensee has submitted a written policy regarding maintaining boundaries with clients, as required by the terms of the January 13, 1995 Stipulation and Consent Order.

5. Based on the foregoing, the Board concludes that Licensee has complied with and fulfilled the order issued by the Board on January 13, 1995, and hereby issues the following ORDER:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an unconditional license to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Licensee, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statutes and rule.
