**ORDER OF
UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE**

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Board of Dentistry ("Board") received a complaint alleging that Jeffrey Soule, D.D.S., ("Licensee"), had engaged in fraud and/or deception when he billed for services other than those actually performed, changed the date of service in order to receive payment, performed unnecessary treatment, allowed registered dental assistants and unregistered dental assistants to practice dentistry without a license and to perform services beyond the scope of their legal authority, engaged in unprofessional conduct, and habitually over-indulged in the use of intoxicating liquors;

WHEREAS, the Board's Complaint Committee held a conference with Licensee on May 29, 1990. As a result of the conference, Licensee and the Complaint Committee entered into a stipulation and order which was approved by the Board on July 12, 1991 ("Stipulation and Order"). Pursuant to paragraph 9 of the Stipulation and Order, Licensee was required to comply with and/or complete the following:

- a. maintain a state of sobriety;
- b. attend Alcohol Anonymous or Dentists for Concerned Dentists meetings on a weekly basis;
- c. submit to alcohol and drug screenings approximately once each month;
- d. complete specified coursework;
- e. limit his practice in the areas of endodontics and periodontics until completing the required coursework;

- f. meet monthly for a period of 24 months with a supervising dentist for the purpose of reviewing a random selection of patient records;
- g. submit a five-page paper addressing Licensee's understanding of the American Dental Association's position on amalgam restorations;
- h. submit a report to the Board after reviewing authorized functions with each dental assistant employed in his practice;
- i. have each patient sign an insurance claim form each time a claim form is submitted for payment, and have verified by the supervising dentist;
- j. obtain a mental health evaluation and submit the results of the evaluation to the Board;
- k. cooperate with the Board when the Board seeks information regarding Licensee's compliance with the Stipulation and Order; and
- l. reimburse the Board \$10,000.

WHEREAS, on November 29, 1994, the Board received Licensee's written petition requesting that the Board remove the conditions from his license;

WHEREAS, the Complaint Committee reviewed Licensee's petition and requested additional information from Licensee to confirm his compliance with the Stipulation and Order;

WHEREAS, the Complaint Committee determined that Licensee has complied with the limitations and conditions set forth in paragraph 9 of the Stipulation and Order;

WHEREAS, the Board, having convened on June 9, 1995 to review Licensee's petition, and having determined that Licensee has complied with the Stipulation and Order, does hereby issue the following:

ORDER


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulation and Order adopted by the Board on July 12, 1991 is RESCINDED and shall have no future force or effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE to practice dentistry in the State of Minnesota be conferred upon Licensee, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
