ORDER OF  
UNLIMITED AND UNCONDITIONAL  
LICENSE

The Minnesota Board of Psychology (Board) convened on June 17, 2016, to review the petition of Lisette Wright, MA, LP (Licensee) for removal of the conditions and restrictions placed on her license by a Stipulation and Consent Order, adopted and implemented by the Board on February 20, 2015 (February 2015 Order). Having considered the Complaint Resolution Committee's (Committee) recommendation that Licensee be granted an unlimited and unconditional license, the Board determines that Licensee has complied with and fulfilled all conditions set forth in the February 2015 Order as follows:

1. Pursuant to paragraph 4.a., Licensee practiced psychology only under the supervision of a supervising psychologist for a period of no less than one (1) year.
2. Pursuant to paragraph 4.a.1., Licensee caused to be submitted to the Committee reports every three (3) months from the supervisor.
3. Pursuant to paragraph 4.b., Licensee limited her practice to no more than five (5) clients per week.
4. Pursuant to paragraph 4.c., Licensee continued in therapy with her treating psychologist for a period of no less than one (1) year, and caused to be submitted to the Committee reports every three (3) months from the therapist.

The Committee has verified Licensee's compliance with the remedy listed in paragraphs 4 and 5, and all subsequent paragraphs of the February 2015 Order.


Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the following:

**ORDER**

Licensee shall be granted an **UNLIMITED AND UNCONDITIONAL LICENSE** to practice psychology in the State of Minnesota, such license to carry all duties, benefits, responsibilities, and privileges inherent therein through Minnesota statute and rule.
