### Required Skills (to be scored as pass/fail)

The following skills are required for resource(s) being submitted. These are scored as pass/fail.

- B.S or B.A degree (4 year) **or** an Associate's degree (2 year) with 5 years' experience in PL/SQL Programming/Development
- Position requires a minimum of five (5) years of experience in designing, developing, and testing applications utilizing a combination of the following: PL/SQL, or Oracle (10g or 11g).
- Experience utilizing migration and version control systems.
- 2 years' experience incorporating WCAG 2.0 and other accessibility requirements into projects.
- ~~Experience with secure coding principals such as OWASP Top 10, SANS top 25~~
- ~~Experience with IRS Pub 1075 and NIST 800-53 rev4~~

### Desired Skills

Points will be scored based on the following criteria as well:

- Computer Science or Information Technology degree
- Proven understanding of all aspects of the Software Development Life Cycle (SDLC)
- Experience with health insurance programs
- Expertise in PL/SQL related to enrollment systems
- Proven, i.e. resume-worthy, experience working with the following
  - Data Architecture, Data Analysis, Data Modeling
  - Enterprise Data Warehousing

**Question 1:** Can you please elaborate on why you're choosing to source two people for these unusual hours? *"One for 52 weeks @ 30 hours/week and one for 26 weeks @ 15 hours/week."*

**Answer 1:** These are augmentation staff that will be matched to other state staff and we determined that 2 part-time working in parallel would work better for us than one full-time. We also have a need for one person to stay longer to help with knowledge transfer after the initial services have been completed.

**Question 2:** The part time PL/SQL developer requirement for RFO0066 is an onsite requirement or the developers could work remotely as well?
