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**REGISTRATION TO PROVIDE PAY TELEPHONE SERVICE
IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA**

Minnesota Statute section 237.036 requires owner or operators of coin-operated or public pay telephones in the State of Minnesota to register with the Minnesota Department of Commerce and the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission 90 days before beginning operation in the state.

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2. The Registrant must agree to comply with the following requirements listed in Minn. Stat. section 237.036, pt. d and e:
- A. Provide immediate coin-free access, to the extent technically feasible, to 911 emergency service or to another approved emergency service; and
 - B. Provide free access to the telecommunications relay service for the communications impaired.
 - C. Owners of coin-operated or public pay telephones must post the following information at each coin-operated or public pay telephone location: (1) customer service and complaint information, including the name, address, and telephone number of the owner of the coin-operated or public pay telephone and the operator service handling calls from the coin-operated or public pay telephone; a toll-free number of the appropriate telephone company for the resolution of complaints; and the toll-free number of the public utilities commission; and (2) a toll-free number at which consumers can obtain pricing information regarding rates, charges, terms, and conditions of local and long-distance calls.

As a provider of pay operated telephone service, I agree that my pay telephone(s) has(have) the operational characteristics listed above and will be operated in accordance with the requirements of Minn. Stat. section 237.036.

I understand that registration will permit me to provide only pay telephone service in the State of Minnesota and will not authorize provision of any other telecommunications services
