- \$113 million Federal LIHEAP allocation
- 130,000 HHs served
- 5450 ERR events - \$6.5 million

- Applications Post 5/6/15 (ROOM date)
- Transferred to the Queue
 - For applications denied ‘Out of funds’ or ‘End of Program,’ coordinate with your local EAP staff to move applications to the queue
 - All other, remember to move your apps to the Queue before Oct. 1

Program Implementation Dates

- July 24: Local Plan, ICD, A16 PESS Sent to SP
- August 3: Annual Consumption gathering begins
- August 4: *FFY16 EAP Policy Manual*
- August 12 & 13: FFY16 EAP Annual Training
- August 20: Local Plan & ICD Due back to Commerce
- August 20: First day A16 PESS plans can be submitted for FFY16
- August 24-September 7: Annual Mailing
- September 25: Contracts packages due at Commerce
- September 30: Contracts Executed- Last day to Move Apps to WAP queue
October 1: Program Starts - Benefit Tables –Start up Allocation

FFY16

- Eligibility
 - Citizenship
 - USHHS Information Memorandum
 - Definition of Household
 - Home Ownership Documentation
 - Contracts for Deed
 - Mobile homes
- Must be filed with local authorities

FFY16

- ERR
 - EC motors
 - EAP ERR fund for start up
 - Procurement

FFY16

- Tracking and Performance Measures
 - National Performance Work Group for LIHEAP
 - Are developing and implementing Performance Measure reporting requirements
 - A key measure is identifying fuel types for ERR
