## **GENERAL REPORT OF PROCEEDINGS**

## **November 1, 2013**

Pursuant to the requirements of Minnesota Statutes section 60B.09, subdivision 1, the Commissioner of Commerce provides the following biennial report of proceedings as of November 1, 2013:

- 1. The Minnesota District Court placed Minnesota Surety and Trust Company (MSTC) in liquidation on November 22, 2011 and appointed the Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Commerce as liquidator.
- 2. There are no other proceedings under Minnesota Statutes sections 60B.15, 60B.20, 60B.52, 60B.53, and 60B.55 pending against other insurers.
- 3. As provided by Minnesota Statutes section 60B.01, subdivision 4, the purpose of the liquidation of MSTC was to protect the interests of insureds, creditors, and the public generally.
- 4. No orders were issued against MSTC pursuant to Minnesota Statutes sections 60B.11, 60B.12 or 60B.13.
