### Can I get real estate continuing education credit for the time that I spend teaching a Minnesota-approved real estate continuing education course?

---

#### Commerce Answer

Yes! Minnesota-approved instructors earn three hours of continuing education credit for each classroom hour of approved instruction that they deliver if they attend the course in its entirety. Licensees should note that no more than half of the continuing education hours required for renewal of your real estate license may be earned as a qualified instructor. Instructors and students receive credit for a course once a licensing period, meaning that if you serve as an instructor for a course two times, you can obtain three credits, not six.

To file for instructor continuing education credit, submit the [Application for Instructor Extra CE Credit form](#) available on the Commerce Department website.
