

Wholesale Transport Provider Registration Form

General Information and Filing Instructions

Minnesota Statute, Section 237.132(a), requires all Wholesale Transport Providers register with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission. The registration is to include the company name, address, a contact name and a telephone number available to other carriers that will be answered within normal business hours. Telecommunications Service Providers and Wholesale Transport Providers are prohibited from knowingly contracting with a wholesale transport provider that is not registered in Minnesota. The Department of Commerce maintains a list of registered Wholesale Transport Providers on its website.

Wholesale transport providers shall update their registration information when changes occur, but no less frequently than annually.

The 2018 docket number is Docket No. 18-23. The 2019 docket number will be Docket No. 19-23, etc.

Filing Instructions

Go to eFiling to set up an account. A User ID and password will be emailed to you soon after account set up. Use your eFiling User ID and password every time you submit a new document. Submission of this completed form will satisfy the requirements of the new statute. Email efiling.admin@state.mn.us with any questions.
