The Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has authorized the Department of Commerce (Department) to establish a Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC) to advise the Commission on the routes to be evaluated and the impacts and issues to be considered in the comparative environmental analysis. The Department has solicited CAC nominations from local units of government located along NPUC's proposed route and alternative routes identified in the application. The second meeting of the CAC will be from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 19, 2007 at the Taconite Community Center. This meeting is open to the public, but participation in the meeting is limited to CAC members. A final report from the CAC will be available for public review after the CAC concludes its tasks.
