A minor alteration is a change in an existing energy facility that does not result in significant changes in the human or environmental impact of the facility (Minnesota Rules, part 7850.4800). At the close of the comment period, the Commission will decide whether to authorize a minor alteration, bring the matter to the Commission for consideration, or determine that the alteration is not minor and requires a full permitting decision.

**Project Background:** On June 24, 2011, the Commission issued a route permit to Xcel Energy and Great River Energy for the construction and operation of a 213-mile 345-kilovolt high-voltage transmission line between Fargo, North Dakota and St. Cloud, Minnesota, along a specified route.

On May 22, 2013, Xcel Energy and Great River Energy applied to the Commission for a minor alteration to the approved route. The minor alteration is being requested to address landowner concerns in four locations in Grant and Otter Tail counties.
