Figure 1.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Corcoran³





Figure 1.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Corcoran

Figure 2.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Deephaven





Figure 2.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Deephaven

Figure 3.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Hopkins




Figure 3.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Hopkins




Figure 4.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Long Lake




Figure 4.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Long Lake




Figure 5.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Medicine Lake




Figure 5.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Medicine Lake




Figure 6.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Medina





Figure 6.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Medina

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Figure 7.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Minnetonka





Figure 7.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Minnetonka

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Figure 8.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Minnetonka Beach




Figure 8.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Minnetonka Beach




Figure 9.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Orono





Figure 9.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Orono

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Figure 10.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Plymouth




Figure 10.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Plymouth




Figure 11.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Shorewood





Figure 11.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Shorewood

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Figure 12.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Wayzata





Figure 12.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Wayzata

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Figure 13.1: Land Use Comparison Over Time – City of Woodland





Figure 13.2: 2030 Planned Land Use – City of Woodland

Figure 14: City of Plymouth Population and Households⁸





Figure 15: City of Medina Population and Households

Figure 16: Greater Study Area


