Whereas North Dakota Pipeline Company, LLC has applied to the State of Minnesota Public Utilities commission for permission to construct and operate a new crude oil pipeline called the Sandpiper Pipeline and;

Whereas, the Sandpiper Pipeline, scheduled to begin construction in 2015 would carry 375,000 barrels of crude oil per day from the Bakken Shale Oil formation in North Dakota across Minnesota to an Enbridge shipping terminal in Superior, Wisconsin and;

Whereas, a significant portion of the Sandpiper Crude Oil Pipeline's proposed route crosses the Mississippi River immediately below Itasca State Park and near many of the highest quality lakes, across rivers and wetlands in Minnesota and Hubbard County and;

Whereas, the Minnesota Public Utility Commission has scheduled public meetings, hearings and public comment periods on the proposed Sandpiper Pipeline and the public comment period ends on April 4, 2014 and;

Whereas, many landowners in Hubbard County, Hubbard Township and the Long Lake area are seasonal residents in Minnesota and are interested in learning about and / or participating in the public review of this crude oil pipeline and are either unaware of the proposal or unable to fully participate in the public review process;

LONG LAKE AREA ASSOCIATION (HUBBARD COUNTY) INC HEREBY RESOLVES TO PETITION THE MINNESOTA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION TO EXTEND THE PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND HOLD ADDITIONAL PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETINGS AND HEARINGS DURING A PERIOD THAT IS MORE INCLUSIVE OF THE MANY LANDOWNERS WHO ARE SEASONAL RESIDENTS IN MINNESOTA AND REQUESTS THAT THE OPPORTUNITY FOR FULL PUBLIC EDUCATION ABOUT AND PARTICIPATION IN THE PERMITTING PROCESS FOR THE ROUTING PERMIT FOR THE SANDPIPER CRUDE OIL PIPELINE NOT END UNTIL AUGUST 1, 2014.
