June 2004	Site Permit No. 04-75-PPS-Xcel Blue Lake Route Permit No. 04-75-PPS- Blue Lake Pipeline Permit No. 04-82-PRP-Xcel Blue Lake	Three permits were issued to Xcel Energy to expand the Blue Lake Generating Plant by installing two 160 MW turbines, to construct a new 115/230 double circuit transmission line about 4000 feet long, and to construct an eleven mile long 16 inch pipeline to bring natural gas to the Blue Lake Plant.
June 2004	Faribault Energy Park, LLC, Permit Amendment	The three permits issued to Faribault Energy Park in May were amended to name the Minnesota Municipal Power Agency as the permittee.
September 2004	Route Permit No. 03-63-TR-Xcel	Route Permit for 24 mile long 161 kV line between Lakefield Junction Substation in Jackson County and the Fox Lake Substation in Martin County.
September 2004	Wind Site Permit No. 04-83-LWECS-McNeilus	A wind Site Permit issued to G. McNeilus Wind, LLC, for up to an 18.2 MW wind project in Dodge County.
