

# MEQB Citizen Advisory Task Force Meeting Notice

**Announcing the scheduled meetings of an EQB appointed Citizen Advisory Task Force to discuss a proposed 161 kV transmission line route in Jackson and Martin Counties.**

The Minnesota Environmental Quality Board (MEQB) is expecting an application for a route permit for a new 24 mile long, 161 kV High Voltage Transmission Line (HVTL) , between Lakefield Junction and Fox Lake substations in Southwestern Minnesota. The Chair of the Minnesota Environmental Quality Board has appointed a Citizen Advisory Task Force to review route alternatives, and environmental and social impacts to be considered in the permitting process. There are meetings of this group scheduled to take place Wednesday, September 24, and October 8, 2003, all in the City of Jackson Council Chambers from 6:30 to 9:00 PM.
