**NOTICE OF MINOR ALTERATION APPLICATION
AND COMMENT PERIOD**

**In the Matter of the Application by ITC Midwest, LLC, for a Minor Alteration
to the Freeborn to Hayward 161 kV Transmission Line in Freeborn County, Minnesota**

Commission Docket Number: ET6675/MC-11-954

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on September 26, 2011, ITC Midwest, LLC (ITC) applied to the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for a minor alteration to rebuild the Freeborn to Hayward 161 kilovolt (kV) transmission line in Freeborn County, Minn. The proposed rebuild includes: (1) reconductoring the line, (2) replacement of existing transmission line structures, and (3) relocating a small segment of the line on new easements to accommodate local setback requirements (see attached maps).

ITC maintains that the project as proposed constitutes a minor alteration. A minor alteration is a change in an existing energy facility that does not result in significant changes in the human or environmental impact of the facility (Minn. Rules 7850.4800). Department of Commerce, Energy Facility Permitting (EFP) staff, on behalf of the Commission, is providing notice of ITC's application for a minor alteration and associated comment period. At the close of the comment period, the Commission will decide whether to authorize a minor alteration or determine that the alteration is not minor and requires a full permitting decision.

Comment Period. Comments will be accepted on this application for a minor alteration until 4:30 PM on **October 14, 2011**. Comments are sought on whether the proposed project is a minor alteration, and conditions that may be appropriate should the project be authorized as a minor alteration.

Figure 1 Project Map


