



Photo #7. DNR Forestry color infrared air photo from 1994 for the area that includes Parcel 75 shows that the site was surrounded by open space composed of oak savanna, pasture and farmland; the site was still ecologically connected to similar habitat types, while 2002 aerial shows the that the site has been impacted and ecologically isolated by urban developments on the east, west and south, and the Highway 169 transportation corridor to the north. For orientation purposes, the Blue Lake Generation Facility is located in the upper left corner of both photos and Parcel 75 is to the southeast in the center of both photos.



Photos #8 – 13. In many areas red cedar, large numbers of aspen, Tartarian honeysuckle, prickly ash and common buckthorn have overgrown the site, further increasing the shading of the ground layer. During the April 14 site visit large amounts of garlic mustard were also found on the site. Large and small Buckthorn were found on the site; the green vegetation in the background of the lower photo is Tartarian honeysuckle.
