Gentlemen: I am writing on behalf of the new owner of the former "north" Wenner property (which we have previously discussed). The new owner, Drummer Properties, would like to express the following regarding the expansion of the transmission lines along their property boundaries:

1. Their preference is to have the extension of Adams Street along the southern boundary of the Drummer parcel on the north and the remaining Wenner property on the south be straight east-to-west, without the potential northerly jog around Xcel Energy's existing transmission property.
2. Drummer Properties is requesting authorization from Xcel Energy to construct the holding ponds for the development of the Drummer property under the existing and future pole locations on the property.

We do not support the project route proposed by the City of Mankato.



Mr. Birkholz and Mr. Johnson:

I am writing as the real estate representative for the Sohler family, whose property is located at the intersection of Thompson Ravine Road and 589th Avenue in Mankato. The Sohlers received the Notice of Public Information Meeting regarding Xcel Energy's expansion/upgrade of the transmission lines in Mankato, however will not be able to attend the meeting on August 25th..

The current proposal has the transmission line running south on the east side of County Road 12 until it intersects with 589th Avenue when it will jog over to the west side (on the Sohler property) all the way to Thompson Ravine Road, then it will turn west on the north side of Thompson Ravine Road/County Road 3 for up to 0.5 miles (again on the Sohler property).

The Sohler's would strongly prefer that the portion of the line running south along 589th Avenue be located on the east side of the road (they also own this property) in order to limit the negative impact on their property to just the 0.5 miles along the north side of Thompson Ravine Road/County Road 3.

David, we would like to add a comment regarding the proposed transmission line.

Regarding the 3rd comment below, we would ask that the line be located on the east side of the future CSAH 12 extension, which is north/south route between Sections 2 and 3. The alignment should be closely coordinated with Blue Earth County – Al Forsberg, County Engineer.

David, just to confirm that the room is available and will be ready. It has power point capability if needed. Just bring a cd. I will not be able to attend the meeting on the 25th, but someone will be available to assist with the room.

In regards to the project, we (the City Community Development Department) would like to submit the following comments:

1. The new line is located in the flight hazard areas of the Mankato Regional Airport – both existing and proposed as part of the runway extension. The line must conform to the standards and height limits of the hazard areas. I believe Xcel has coordinated a review with our contract engineer – Bolton and Menk, but the final plans should be confirmed.
2. In Sections 7 and 8, in the vicinity of the Alternative Area, the line may impact several important economic development projects of the City. The route should be coordinated with the City in order to avoid conflict with pending projects. We would prefer that the line follow proposed roads in the area.
3. The City and County are planning an extension of CSAH 12 with an interchange at Highway 14. The power line alignment near the Lime Siding is within the proposed corridor of the CSAH 12 extension and the line placement should take into account the future roadway.
