

MINNESOTA YOUTH SUCCESS STORY: BRANDON

Brandon worked at a local small engine shop while he successfully completed probation. At subsequent court proceedings, Brandon's worksite supervisors and the PIC staff offered positive support. When all of the court proceedings were completed, Brandon returned to the local small engine shop where he successfully worked to pay all court fines and restitution. Brandon missed zero days of school and passed all of his high school classes. When his work experience ended at the small engine shop, the positive work references from his supervisor and his increased self-confidence lead to

another job where he continues to work 15 to 20 Hours per week while he finishes his senior year of high school.
