We know your time is valuable, your lives are busy and time is precious, but please agree to participate if you are called about the National Core Indicators survey regarding the Minnesota Department of Human Services home and community based supports.

Vital Research, an independent research firm working for the Minnesota Department of Human Services, will need the permission of guardians to call some people, while those who manage their own affairs will be contacted directly. All the interviews must be done in person. If a person needs help to answer questions, others are allowed to assist on certain questions.

Vital Research will be calling to book an appointment to conduct this survey between January and March so we can get the opinions and ideas of the people we serve. This is part of a national survey conducted across states to find out how well developmental disability services meet people's needs. Then the results are compared across states. The Minnesota Department of Human Services will use your input to help us improve services for people with developmental disabilities and their families.

Vital Research will add up all the responses and send the TOTAL results to the Minnesota Department of Human Services. Case managers, providers, support workers, counties and the state will NOT know how any individual or their family responded. No individual survey responses will come back to the Minnesota Department of Human Services. Your comments will be collected and sent in without your names.

Answer the questions as honestly as you can, secure in the knowledge that your responses are confidential. Tell us what works, and tell us what needs improvement. Your time and your privacy are very important to us. And this survey is very important to all Minnesotans with developmental disabilities and their families.
