Minnesota Statutes, Section 349.213, Subdivision 1, paragraph (f)(2), allows a city or county to require (by ordinars) an organization to contribute up to 10% per year of net profits, less taxes assessed on lawful gambling, to a fund that the county administers. The 10% contribution requirement may only be applied to net profits derived from lawful gambling to at premises within the city or county's jurisdiction. Net profits are gross profits less amounts expended for (a) allowable ex and (b) lawful gambling taxes.

Organizations must make 10% fund checks payable to the city or county requiring the funds, and not to any other bayes ilcensed organization that contributes to the 10% fund may not be a beneficiary of that fund.
