- WHEREAS: There is a growing need for cooperation among automobile drivers, motorcyclists, bicyclists, and pedestrians to reduce injuries and fatalities when using our streets and highways; and
- WHEREAS: It is beneficial for all Minnesotans to increase their knowledge of the laws regarding the use of roadways; and
- WHEREAS: By working together to increase knowledge of the needs and responsibilities of all road and highway users, and encouraging users to exercise added caution, we strive to make our roads safer, enabling motorcyclists throughout Minnesota to have an enjoyable riding season.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2014, as:
