Proclamation

WHEREAS: The National Pan-Hellenic Council of Minneapolis and St. Paul (NPHC – MSP) is an alumni council organization committed to community service, comprised of other community service organizations with the shared goal of bringing about positive programs to benefit Minnesota, including mentoring; providing scholarships to young people; education; health services outreach; and tackling civil rights issues; and

WHEREAS: Alpha Kappa Alpha, Alpha Phi Alpha, Zeta Phi Beta, Iota Phi Theta, Sigma Gamma Rho, Phi Beta Sigma, and Delta Sigma Theta sororities and fraternities enrich and engage their communities beyond college graduation, by providing mental stimulation and support through interaction with community leaders, state legislators, and associates; and

WHEREAS: NPHC – MSP Day at the Capitol marks a coordinated effort among member organizations with a strategic focus to motivate social and economic change through civic engagement; and

WHEREAS: MPHC – MSP Day at the Capitol is a non-partisan event, where members of the African American community are encouraged to engage in meaningful dialogue with legislators, constitutional officers, and members of the judiciary regarding issues, which disproportionately affect them.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, March 14, 2014, as:
