
Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Minnesota's state fair is known for its wide assortment of food, both classic and creative, including tasty choices like Pronto Pups, cheese curds, deep-fried candy bars, and all other manner of fried foods on-a-stick; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Fair has provided generations of Minnesotans, young and old, an opportunity to get together for a few weeks of summer fun.
