## SNAPSHOT | Governor Dayton's Water Quality & Infrastructure Plan

Building a Better Minnesota

Governor Mark Dayton has proposed a \$219.7 million plan to modernize Minnesota's aging water infrastructure and protect groundwater from contamination. Governor Dayton's plan would allocate \$167 million of his Jobs Bill proposal to assist communities across the state that cannot afford to make critical investments in aging water infrastructure. This snapshot breaks down some of the projects that would be completed under Governor Dayton's proposal, through increased funding for Public Facilities Authority grant and loan programs. This snapshot illustrates the total funding that will go into each project, including the state's share.
