## Governor Dayton's 2018 Public Works Bill

*Preparing Minnesotans for Good Jobs and Bright Futures*

The University of Minnesota and Minnesota State systems are critical to our state's economy and quality of life. They educate more 440,000 students for good jobs every year. They generate new ideas and technologies that support economic growth. And with nearly 60 campuses, our public colleges and universities support the vitality of local communities across the state.

Despite the importance of our higher education systems, Minnesota's public college and universities have significant deferred maintenance needs over the next decade. In fact, over the next ten years the University of Minnesota's five campuses are expected to have \$3.4 billion in maintenance needs. The Minnesota State system is similarly expected to need approximately \$2 billion to simply maintain and restore its current infrastructure. Governor Dayton's public works bill would invest \$542 million in higher education projects, reducing the backlog of deferred maintenance needs. The full list of projects is below.

### Public Colleges and Universities: \$5.4 Billion in Deferred Maintenance Needs Across Minnesota

Key Number	Description
<b>\$5.4 Billion</b>	The University of Minnesota and Minnesota State system campuses face \$5.4 billion in deferred maintenance needs over the next decade.
<b>\$542 Million</b>	Governor Dayton's public works proposal would invest \$299 million in the University of Minnesota and \$243 million in Minnesota State system, totaling \$542 million.
<b>61 Projects</b>	Governor Dayton's public works bill would help public colleges and universities complete at least 61 urgently-needed projects.
<b>33 Counties</b>	Governor Dayton's public works bill would invest in projects, benefiting public colleges and universities in 33 different Minnesota counties.

<b>43 Campuses</b>	Governor Dayton’s public works bill would help complete urgently-needed projects on 43 different public college and university campuses.
