WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota Duluth defeated the University of Michigan 3-2 in overtime, with native Minnesotan Kyle Schmidt scoring the winning goal; and

WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota Duluth Men's Hockey Team has the distinction of being the NCAA Division I Champions for the year 2011; and
