Enterprise Mode Setting


If you use Internet Explorer 11 while using Statewide Systems and are having difficulty with the appearance or how pages are functioning you may need to check Enterprise Mode. IE-11 Enterprise Mode is a setting that mimics earlier versions of Internet Explorer.

When using Internet Explorer 11, each of the systems must have Enterprise Mode checked on or off based on the table below:

SWIFT	Unchecked
ELM	Unchecked
BPAS	Unchecked
CBS	Unchecked
FNTS	Unchecked
DE	Unchecked
EPM—SWIFT Data Warehouse	Unchecked


How do you know what Internet Explorer version you are using?

Click **Help** link on the browser menu and then **About Internet Explorer**.




Close the About Internet Explorer window.

When Enterprise mode is enabled, it will be checked in the Tools menu and you will also see an icon next to the web page URL that will tell you are in Enterprise Mode.



If you do not need Enterprise Mode enabled, click on the check mark to disable.
