When sending a message to a legislator.

- 1. Give your name and address.
- 2. If you live in the legislator's district, also say that you live in the district (then you are a constituent).
- 3. Describe the issue or problem, or provide a bill number (if there is a bill that addresses your issue of problem).
- 4. Explain how this issue affects or impacts you and your family (be brief).
- 5. If there is a bill that talks about your issue or problem, ask for the legislator to do something—support or oppose the bill.
- 6. Say thank you.
