The following is ~~abstracted~~ from a letter written November 15, 1948 by Director Carl J. Jackson:

"I consulted Mr. Isensee in the Attorney General's office relative to the use of firearms in apprehending anyone who escapes from the Defective Delinquent group. I have been concerned because I do not want you or our office to get into any unpleasanties.

Mr. Isensee informed me that these people are definitely committed as feebleminded and do not carry any felony charge even though they may have committed a felony in connection with their deficiency. Therefore, we had better be very careful when any of them escape. Certainly you cannot be held responsible if they escape and you are not permitted to use the same methods of apprehension that you would in the case of a felon."
