Introduction:

Minnesota's Program for the Mentally Retarded and Epileptic

Department of Public Welfare

Minnesota Statutes state that it is the duty of the Commissioner of Public Welfare to promote the enforcement of all laws for the protection of the mentally retarded, to cooperate with child-helping and child-placing agencies of a public or private character, and to take the initiative in all matters involving the interests of such children where adequate provision has not already been made. Major responsibilities are:

1. Program planning and coordination of services for the mentally retarded with both public and private agencies.
2. Administration of grant-in-aid program for Daytime Activity Centers for the Mentally Retarded.
3. Administration of guardianship program for the mentally retarded.
4. Standard setting and program development for state residential facilities for mentally retarded.
5. Standard setting and licensing of foster homes, private group care facilities, and daytime activity centers for the mentally retarded.
6. Development of necessary community services.
7. Psychological services for county welfare departments and private social agencies.
8. Crippled Children's Services for physically handicapped and the retarded.

County Welfare Departments

County welfare boards are responsible as the agents of the Commissioner of Public Welfare to carry out his statutory responsibilities for the retarded in each county. This means that they have the responsibility for promoting the enforcement of all laws for the protection of the mentally retarded, cooperating with public and private agencies, and taking the initiative in developing programs and services for the retarded. Services provided by the 87 county welfare boards include casework services, financial assistance, residential care such as found in foster homes, private group care facilities, state residential facilities, nursing and rest homes, and continuous planning responsibility for those under guardianship to the Commissioner of Public Welfare.

Community Mental Health Centers

Community Mental Health Centers are authorized by statute to provide the following services:

1. Collaborative and cooperative service with public health and other groups for programs of prevention of mental illness, mental retardation, and other psychiatric disabilities,
2. Information and educational services to the general public, and lay and professional groups.
3. Consultative services to schools, courts, and health and welfare agencies, both public and private.
4. Out-patient diagnostic and treatment services.
5. Rehabilitative services for patients suffering from mental or emotional disorders, mental retardation and other psychiatric conditions, particularly those who have received prior treatment in an in-patient facility.

Daytime Activity Centers for Retarded

A grant-in-aid program for daytime activity centers for the mentally retarded is administered on the basis of 50% state funds matching 50% local funds. The centers may provide daytime activity for school-age mentally retarded children who are neither educable nor trainable, and for mentally retarded children and adults who are unable to attend school because of their chronological age and are unable to independently engage in ordinary community activities. They provide counseling services to parents or guardians.

The Minnesota Association for Retarded Children owns and operates a 75 acre resort on Clearwater Lake, Annandale, Minnesota which provides camping for mentally retarded children in Minnesota who can benefit from the camp program, whether or *not* their parents are members of the Association. This camp will fill the following functions:

1. Camping for retarded boys and girls who are able to benefit independently from the program.
2. Family camping for those families whose retarded child is not able, for medical or other reasons, to go to camp alone.
3. Spring and fall sessions for adult residents of state schools and hospitals for the retarded.
4. Tent camping for organized groups of retarded, such as boy and girl Scouts and recreation groups.
5. Special conferences on mental retardation.
