**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF ADDITIONAL NOTICE
PLAN AND DUAL NOTICE**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Ann C. O'Reilly upon the Minnesota Board of Architecture, Engineering, Land Surveying, Landscape Architecture, Geoscience and Interior Design's (Board) request for a legal review under Minn. R. 1400.2060, .2080 (2013) of the Additional Notice Plan and Dual Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules in the above-captioned proceeding.

Under its Additional Notice Plan, the Board plans to mail copies of the Dual Notice of intent to Adopt Rules and the proposed rules to:

- the American Institute of Architects;
- the Minnesota Society of Professional Engineers;
- the American Council of Engineering Companies of Minnesota;
- the Minnesota Society of Professional Surveyors;
- the Minnesota Association of County Surveyors
- the Minnesota Chapter of the American Society of Landscape Architects
- the Minnesota Section of the American Institute of Professional Geologists
- the Minnesota Association of Professional Soil Scientists
- the Northland Chapter of the International Interior Design Association;
- the Minnesota Chapter of the American Society of Interior Designers;
- the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying;
- the National Association of State Boards of Geology;
- the National Council of Soil Science Examiners;
- the Minnesota Department of Veteran's Affairs;

- all parties who have registered to be on the Board's rulemaking mailing list under Minn. Stat. § 14.14, subd. 1a; and
- the Minnesota Legislature, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 147.116.

In addition, the Board plans to send a postcard to all current licensees and certificate holders, advising them where to find the Dual Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules, the proposed rules, and the Statement of Need and Reasonableness (SONAR) on the Board's website. There are over 17,000 licensees and certificate holders.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Board,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Additional Notice Plan is **APPROVED**.
2. The Dual Notice is **APPROVED**.
