**ORDER ON REVIEW OF  
ADDITIONAL NOTICE PLAN  
AND DUAL NOTICE**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Barbara L. Neilson upon the request by the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry for a legal review under Minn. R. 1400.2060 and 1400.2080 of the Additional Notice Plan and Dual Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules in the above-captioned proceeding.

Under its Additional Notice Plan, the Department plans to notify various trade associations involved in high pressure piping work as well as the Minnesota State Fire Chiefs Association, the Minnesota State Fire Marshal, the Metropolitan Council, the League of Minnesota Cities, and the Mechanical Inspection Departments of the cities of Minneapolis and St. Paul.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Department,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Additional Notice Plan is **APPROVED**.
2. The Dual Notice is **APPROVED**.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Although not required, it is suggested that slight modifications to the Dual Notice be made prior to publication to conform more closely to the wording suggested in Minn. R. 1400.2540. These changes will clarify that it is the responsibility of the Office of Administrative Hearings and not the agency to hold the public hearing. The suggested modifications are noted in the attachment.
